 - o All committees are bilingual Josefina helps with Spanish translation
- Lunch leading program
 - Students give up their grade lunch and recess to help Kindergarteners during their lunch and recess
 - We will be collecting 4th grade applications for Lunch Leaders on Monday, November 27th, to begin working on Monday, December 4th
- Student Council President and Vice President spoke
 - 5th graders
